Please Use the “Three Rs” at the End of the School Year

Reduce: the amount of trash we collect and haul to the Essex Incinerator!

Reuse: old school supplies. Try to share your used items and supplies, or set up a reuse area where teachers, students and staff can place materials they no longer need that can be utilized by others next fall.

Recycle: during classroom, office, and locker Clean-Out Day.

The end of the year can be the busiest time of year for teachers, students and administrators; it can also be the fullest time of year for our trash cans. Every year when teachers clean out their classrooms, administrators clear out their office desks, and students clean out their lockers, paper and other materials that should be recycled or reused often get needlessly thrown away.
